## Look Up

### *Learn the Story*

- Someone reads the Bible story.
- Someone else retells the passage by memory. Others can fill in what is missing.

### *Dig deeper with these questions*

- Context - Establish the setting and time of the story. What happened right before and after your story? Do you need to define or explain any words for clarity?
- Characters - Take time to get to know each character/person in the story. What can you learn about them?
- Conversations - What did they say and who did they say it to?
- Choices - What choices did each person make? What influenced their choices? Could they have made other choices?
- Consequences - What consequences, either good or bad, happened as a result of the choices or decisions that were made? What was the impact or result?

## Look Forward

This section provides a plan of action. It is important to follow through on the steps you feel God is asking you to take. Create your own questions in this section. If you need some help to get started, here are some general question you could use:

- Which character in the story did you most identify with and why?
- What did you learn about God/people?
- Did you see Satan or evil at work in your story? What did you learn about him?
- If this story is true, how should it change the way you live?
- How did God use this story to speak to you?
- What will you do this week in response to what God is saying to you?
- Who else needs to hear this story?

What is causing you stress? Who needs our help? Close in prayer.
